MEETING OPENED:

Chief Geysen stated that the original drone that Fire Investigation unit wanted was no longer available. The new drone is approximately \$2700.00 more, but he has the funds available in the New Equipment line. On a motion by Commissioner Post and seconded by Vice-Chairman McNamara, the purchase of a new drone was approved, with any cost exceeding the FIU Budget to come out of the New Equipment line. Motion carried. Chief Geysen stated he was going to add a lieutenant position to the Fire Investigation Unit to assist the chief. Commissioner Stuart asked what was going to be done about the bumper on 39-67 that was scratched by the Town's vehicle. It was decided that the scratch is not bad enough to do anything with it at this time.
