Vice-Chairman McNamara made the following statement for the minutes: "As the Board has decided to follow NFPA recommendations regarding the live burn policy in acquired structures, but to continue the current standing policy for training center live burns. If a Level 2 instructor is available, they will be used, but if one is not available, a Level 1 instructor will be required. This is for East Fishkill drills only. A letter will be drafted stating this to absolve Level 2 instructor Frank Lacalamita from liability during training. If a mutual aid company uses the facility for live fire evolutions, they must provide a Level 2 instructor and an authorized member of the East Fishkill Fire District Training Staff must be present." This was agreed to by all commissioners.

NEW BUSINESS:

On a motion by Commissioner Post and seconded by Vice-Chairman McNamara, the 2018 LOSAP funding deposit, in the amount of \$310,000.00, will be made with this month's payables. Commissioner Post made a motion to accept the change orders for 39-14, 39-22, and 39-45 and to authorize the Chairman to sign them. Seconded by Vice-Chairman McNamara and carried. Commissioner Stuart made a motion to allow a member to attend 6 classes at Montour Falls, to include meals, travel, and lodging. Seconded by Commissioner Ehrhart and carried. On a motion by Commissioner Post and seconded by Commissioner Ehrhart, a replacement generator will be purchased for 39-52 at a cost not to exceed \$7,000, to include labor installation, from Hopewell Fire Apparatus.
