November 25, 2024

MEETING OPENED:

The East Fishkill Board of Fire Commissioners held their regular board meeting at headquarters. Chairman Dixon called the meeting to order at 8:00 P.M.

MEMBERS PRESENT:

Those members present were: Chairman Dixon, Vice-Chairman Shultis, Commissioner Jodlowski, Commissioner Freer, and Commissioner Zboinski.

All motions were unanimous, unless otherwise stated.

MOMENT OF SILENCE: For Dennis Gelber from Station 2 and all fallen brothers and sisters in the military, police, and fire and EMS service.

SECRETARY'S REPORT:

The minutes of the October 30 and November 12, 2024 meetings were accepted on a motion by Commissioner Zboinski and seconded by Commissioner Freer. Motion carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

The Treasurer's Report for October 2024 was accepted on a motion by Commissioner Jodlowski and seconded by Commissioner Zboinski. Motion carried.

BILLS PAYABLE:

Commissioner Freer made a motion that the bills from the General Fund totaling \$177,953.38 from the General Fund, all numbered 1114 through 2329, be approved. Seconded by Commissioner Jodlowski and carried.

On a motion by Vice-Chairman Shultis, these applications were approved, pending arson and physicals. Seconded by Commissioner Zboinski and carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

On a motion by Commissioner Freer and seconded by Vice-Chairman Shultis, the NYSLER resolution, as attached to these minutes, was accepted and passed.

Commissioner Freer made a motion to accept the bid from Vander Molen Fire Apparatus for the UTV in the amount of \$63,700. Seconded by Commissioner Zboinski and carried.

A motion was made, pending the successful completion of a permissive referendum, that \$75,000 be authorized to be spent from the Reserve for Major Equipment for the purchase of a UTV and required equipment by Commissioner Freer and seconded by Commissioner Jodlowski.

NEW BUSINESS:

Commissioner Jodlowski made a motion to transfer \$100,000 from NYClass Gen Fund to Tompkins Checking. Seconded by Vice-Chairman Shultis. Chairman Dixon abstained. Motion carried.

On a motion by Commissioner Jodlowski and seconded by Commissioner Zboinski, the EF PBA is approved to use of the parking pad for their Stuff the Cruiser on 12/7 from 12-4 PM.

Commissioner Jodlowski made a motion to approve NYS Chapter 23 IAAI use of meeting room 2/7 and provide lunch. Seconded by Vice-Chairman Shultis and carried.

On a motion by Commissioner Jodlowski and seconded by Commissioner Freer, Station 1 is authorized to transport Santa to the Community Center for the Town Tree Lighting Ceremony on December 7th.

DISTRICT CHIEF: see report.

- 1. Chief Jackson thanked everyone who participated in the funeral procession in Beekman. The District received a thank you from the Town PD for their attendance as well.
- 2. During the quarterly meeting with the Board, the Chief spoke about getting other districts together to apply for the AFG Grant for an air truck. The grant is due in December, so they will have to pass on it this time, but will keep eyes open for next year. Chairman Dixon suggested talking to the neighboring departments in the summer to prep for submission time next year. There are only 24 days left, but maybe they could think of something else to submit for.
- 3. Chief Jackson stated he has received 2 requests for paperwork on incidents East Fishkill did not respond to. Secretary Beyer explained that some people have no idea who responded to their incident so when they call insurance with the address and not the town too, we sometimes get other town's requests.

1st ASSISTANT CHIEF: see report.

1. 1st Assistant Dan Jackson was approached by Tom Jackson Jr from the Northfield MA. Fire Department. They are looking for a used ATV and he thinks the green one would work well for them. They only have a \$100,000 annual budget. Chairman Dixon stated the green ATV gets a lot of use by maintenance and he is not in favor of getting rid of it at this point. They will keep this in mind should that change.

At 8:12 PM, Vice Chairman Shultis made a motion to go into Executive Session to discuss a legal issue. Seconded by Commissioner Freer and carried.

At 8:14 PM, Commissioner Jodlowski made a motion to adjourn the Executive Session. Seconded by Commissioner Zboinski and carried.

There were no actions taken as a result of this Executive Session.
