The East Fishkill Board of Fire Commissioners held their regular board meeting at headquarters. Chairman Shultis called the meeting to order at 8:00 P.M.

**MEMBERS PRESENT:**

Those members present were: Chairman Shultis, Vice-Chairman Dixon, Commissioner Ehrhart, and Commissioner Freer. Commissioner Jodlowski was excused.

All motions were unanimous, unless otherwise stated.

**SECRETARY'S REPORT:**

The minutes of the March 22, 2023 and April 10, 2023, meetings were accepted on a motion by Vice-Chairman Dixon and seconded by Commissioner Freer. Motion carried.

**TREASURER'S REPORT:**

The Treasurer's Reports for March 2023 was accepted on a motion by Vice-Chairman Dixon and seconded by Commissioner Freer. Motion carried.

**BILLS PAYABLE:**

Vice-Chairman Dixon made a motion that the bills from the General Fund totaling \$265,452.57 and \$4,866.10 from the Reserve Fund for Building & Land Acquisitions numbered 345 through 460, as proposed, be approved. Seconded by Commissioner Freer and carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Ehrhart and seconded by Commissioner Freer to approve sending a member to Putnam County for an Apparatus Aerial Operator class at no cost.

Commissioner Ehrhart made a motion to transfer \$532,392.48 from Mahopac General to NYClass Reserve Major Equipment, \$100,000 from Mahopac General to NYClass B&L, and \$2,467,600.00 from Mahopac General to NYClass General. Vice-Chairman Dixon abstained. All others voted aye – carried.

On a motion by Commissioner Ehrhart and seconded by Vice-Chairman Dixon, two people are authorized to attend the IAAI seminar to include meals, lodging, hotel, & travel. Motion carried.

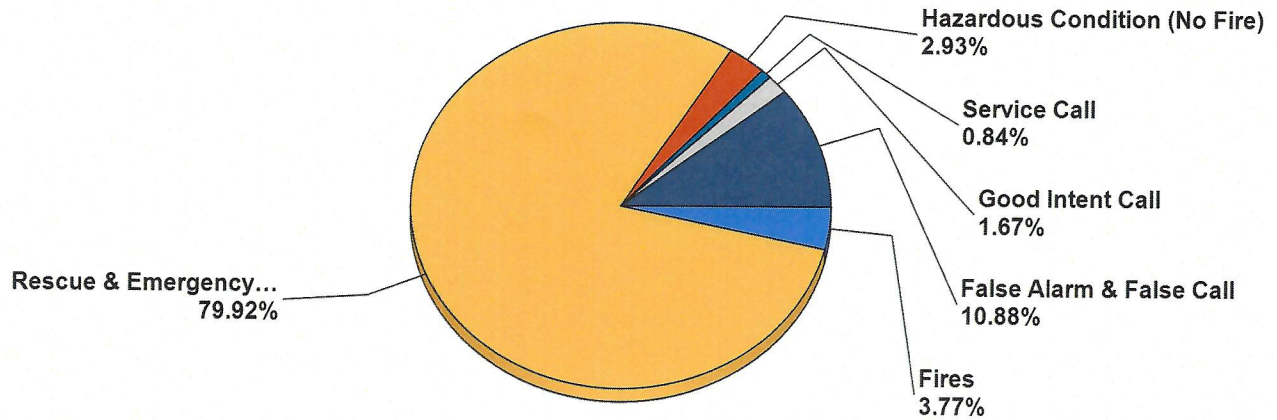
